## Abstract

### Jastorf-kulturen genbesøgt – Når dansk arkæologi bliver politiseret

*This paper examines the evident problems occurring when politics interfere with the archaeological cooperation between modern states. The disputed Jastorf culture of the Pre-Roman Iron Age will serve as a case study on this topic due to the Schleswig-Holstein conflict between Denmark and Germany in 1864, which caused a rather conflicting and biased reception by Danish archaeologists, who were dismissive of the idea of a prehistoric German culture within the modern Danish territory. An argument for an obvious shared materialistic expression will be presented by conducting a retrospective study of the research history, a comparative analysis of two respective Danish and German urnfield burial sites, and finally, by proposing the idea of a Creole society.*
